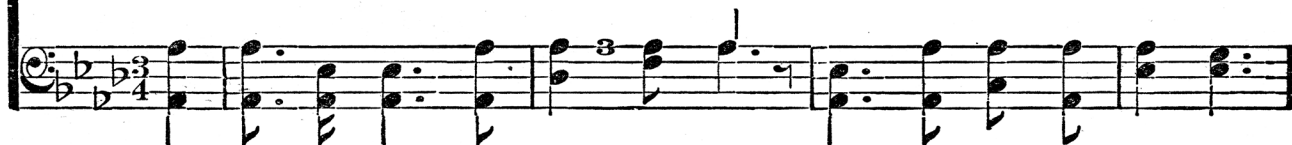


Since I Found My Savior
